Preparation for Pictures to Exe

- Make a folder called Pictures to Exe and within that a folder called Edit files and one called Shows and one for your (resized) image files. (say Pics)
- Also, a Music folder in which you can store your MP3 files.
- Resize your images to, say: 1920 X 1080 pixels. The exception to this is if you want to zoom in or maybe do a big pan on a panorama.)
- When saving your edit file, save it in your new Edit files folder.
- When at the point of Publishing, and you wish to create a pictures to Exe file, save it in your Shows folder. (Other choices are available at this point)
- Do not change your file structure once created!! The edit files need to know where all the components are. [I have suffered image orphan syndrome...not good]
- Remember the old KISS acronym: keep it simple, stupid! You can always gradually increase the complexity as you gain more experience.
- Be your own worst enemy: edit out your weaker images ruthlessly. If you're not sure, delete it! Just because you have a lot of images, that is not an excuse for showing them all!
- When you think you have finished a presentation, save it as an Edit File and look at it again another day. You'll be surprised at how often you can spot a weakness that hadn't been obvious the first time.

Droning on and on about Drones....

What is a drone ?







Unmanned Flying Vehicle













Type of Drone

From 1 January 2023 new drones will have to meet a set of product standards, and some may do before this date. These will be classed from C0 to C4, based on the weight and capability of the drone, and will determine how and where you can fly.


- Drones classed C0 or C1 can be flown in the open A1 sub category
- Drones classed C2 can be flown in the A2 or A3 sub category but if flying in 'A2' you must pass the A2 theory exam (A2 Certificate of Competency or 'A2 CofC')
- Drones classed as C3 and C4 can only be flown in the A3 sub category

Until January 2023 if your drone doesn't have a class marking, you may fly it in the following categories:

- Drones under 250g can be flown in the A1 sub category (there are also some exceptions for drones up to 500g too).
- Drones less than 2kg can be flown in A2 sub category, but you must keep at least 50 meters away from people and pass the A2 theory exam (A2 Certificate of Competency or 'A2 CofC'). If you have not passed the A2 theory exam, you may only fly these drones in the A3 subcategory.
- Drones of 2kg or greater may only be flown in the A3 subcategory.

After 1 January 2023, you can continue to fly a 'legacy' unmarked drone in the following categories:

- Drones under 250g can continue to be flown in the A1 sub category.
- All other drones must only be used in the A3 sub category.



Regulations? A semi trained Monkey could do better.....

Flying Class C0 Drones in A1 Subcategory (Under 250g) C0 drones are small and include toy drones;

- Under 250g maximum take-off mass;
- Maximum speed of 19m/s (approx. 42.5mph);
- Cannot be flown more than 120m (400ft) from the pilot

What training and certification do I need to fly a C0 Drone?

- UK Drone Registration required if camera equipped
- Read manufacturer user manual
- Online training for Commercial operators
- Online foundation test for Commercial operators

Well that's all clear then ??

Red zones are regulated high-risk areas and operation of your drone may be hazardous or prohibited.

Yellow zones indicate regions where operation of your drone may raise security, privacy or safety concerns.

Regulations governing the flight of drones vary from country-to-country, therefore these areas are included for your information. It is your responsibility to check the applicability of any local, state and/or national laws and regulations which may permit or otherwise restrict the operation of your drone. Unless regulations in your region explicitly permit the operation of your drone in this area, we recommend you do not operate your drone here.






- Drones are not permitted to fly over our sites during the opening hours of the monuments. Opening hours can be viewed on each of the site specific pages in our Days Out section.
- A copy of a full CAA permit and pilot's licence must be provided to us in advance of your filming (we will not permit amateurs or those undertaking training hours to operate unmanned aerial vehicles over our sites). Additional items may be required for other forms of aerial photography i.e. kite flying.
- All flights over Cadw property must be performed in accordance with the CAA regulations. A copy of these regulations can be found on the CAA website.
- Cadw reserves the right to refuse your request and charges would apply to your request in most instances. The relevant charges for filming and photography are attached to the application form page.










































Etc etc

Usually lowest power is 1/128 or 1/256

This is the same notation as camera speed BUT IS NOTHING TO DO WITH SPEED!








High Speed Sync

Flash in Standard Mode (non HSS)

Shutter Speed on or below Maximum Flash Sync speed (Group A Shutter Speeds)





Manual

Set flash power

Set Focal length (spread)

Turn on high speed sync if required

Cheat - use TCM button

How clever is this.....

If you have a mirrorless camera, what you see is what you get - so if you need flash it will look dark. But fix on a flash and switch it on and by some clever black magic it will show you what you will get!! If you are feeling really clever.....




Fig 1.6.2 The appearance of the shutter at various speeds.
